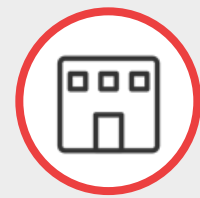
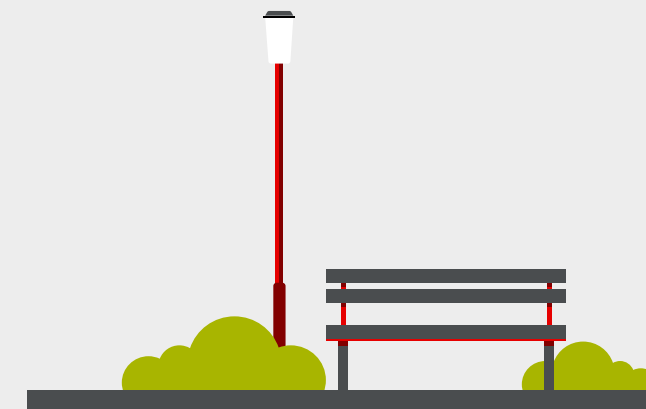

Smart workers

Flexible working is a work arrangement that gives an employee flexibility on how long, where and when they work in line with the needs of the business. Find out about the various Smart worker types your business might employ.



Full-time

Works under an employment contract for 40 hours a week, across 5 days.



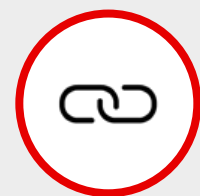
Part-time

Works under an employment contract for less than 40 hours, across 5 days.



Fixed term

Hired on a temporary basis for a specific period.



Flexitime

Works core hours set by the business with flexible hours in the mornings and in the evenings.



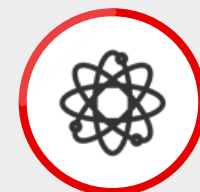
Specified purpose

Hired for a specific project or event.



Shift workers

Works on a shift basis in one, two or three cycles.



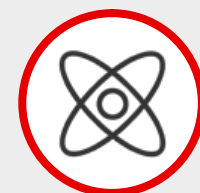
Job-sharing

Shares a full time position with a co-worker.



Term time

Works during term time, usually from September to June.



Casual

Works on a casual basis, working hours vary from week to week.



Remote employee

Works remotely for a part of the week or the full week.

Self-employed



Independent contractor

Hired on a service contract for a specified period of time or on an on-going basis.



Freelancer

Hired on a contract for service on an hourly, daily or set rate.



Gig worker

Hired on a contract for service and paid per gig.
